This consolidation can occur only if the City applies for the Annexation and the Annexation is approved by LAFCO. **[5] PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT 2005PD01 & VESTING TENTATIVE TRACT MAP NO. 061638** is a request to divide the property into six single-family lots for detached condominium units and one lot consisting of shared driveway, guest parking, and common and private open space for recreational uses on the subject site.
