- A. The City is still negotiating with Cingular regarding the second cell site.

- D. We will be offering swim scholarship to low income families with kids who are interested in taking swim lessons.

- H. Budget 2006-07 – The City's budget was cut. We are trying to offer a summer park program. The pool is going strong. This is a preliminary budget. They will have a Public Hearing at the end of May.
