

**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE

Tomatani in his sole discretion to amend, alter or modify the terms, conditions and provisions of the RFP and the attached draft contract provisions to further clarify any questions, issues or inconsistencies that may arise before, during or after the procurement process, and for the additional purpose of ensuring the proper administration of the police referred non-exclusive towing and storage contract.

City Attorney, Glen Shishido stated that the second sentence would be deleted from the recommendation per Councilmember Lambert.

Councilmember Catano moved, seconded by Councilmember Parsons that items 3 through 10 of the City Manager's consent calendar be approved.
