

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE

Mayor/Chairman Guidi called the City Council meeting to order jointly and concurrently at 12:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers of City Hall, 4455 West 126th Street, Hawthorne, California.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE, CALIFORNIA, OPPOSING ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 2922, AN ACT THAT WOULD INCREASE THE SET ASIDE FOR HOUSING FROM 20% IN CURRENT LAW TO 50%.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING A LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN MONETA GARDENS IMPROVEMENT, INC AND THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE FOR USE OF A 2700 SQUARE FEET BUILDING AND ADJACENT 2000 SQUARE FEET PLAYGROUND AREA LOCATED AT 14025 SOUTH CORDARY AVENUE, HAWTHORNE FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATING A PRESCHOOL AND/OR AFTER SCHOOL CHILD CARE AND INSTRUCTION FACILITY.

Mayor Guidi moved, seconded by Councilmember Lambert to hire or put a contract together with Ruttan and Tucker to overhaul our municipal code and be put on the next agenda as a discussion/action item.

Councilmember **Lambert** showed a compilation of pictures that indicate we are not doing what we promised to do. Cars are still parked, trash is still piled high, buses are parked where they don't belong and trucks are in the community.

Councilmember **Lambert** asked that the community show their American spirit by putting out their flags on May 1st.

Mayor **Guidi** asked that the vehicle codes especially be enforced on May 1st as there have been incidents of kids falling out of cars at previous demonstrations.

Councilmember **Velez** was pleased to see the checkpoint and inquired on how many cars had violations. Captain Beerling reported that over 200 tickets were written and three felony arrests were made.

Councilmember **Catano** commented on the illegal immigrant situation, and stated that not all illegals and minorities are bad.

Mayor **Guidi** requested an action/discussion item for the next agenda regarding review of contracts for fuel charges.

City Clerk **English** stated that her main concern is safety for the families in the community and in regards to anyone doing anything illegally, feels that you should let the law work its course.

Mayor Guidi adjourned the meeting at 1:00 p.m.
