

RESOLUTION NO. 7095

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 7068 PERTAINING TO GRAPHICS AND PEDESTAL REQUIREMENTS FOR UNIFORM NEWSRACKS ALONG CRENSHAW BOULEVARD, PRAIRIE AVENUE, HAWTHORNE BOULEVARD, INGLEWOOD AVENUE, AVIATION BOULEVARD, ROSECRANS AVENUE, EL SEGUNDO BOULEVARD, 120TH STREET AND IMPERIAL HIGHWAY PURSUANT TO HAWTHORNE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 12.34.160.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hawthorne (“City”) approved Ordinance No. 1797 adding Chapter 12.34 to the Hawthorne Municipal Code pertaining to the regulation of news racks on the City’s public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, Hawthorne Municipal Code Section 12.34.160 provides that the City Council may, by resolution and from time to time, establish uniform news rack locations; and

WHEREAS, on October 24, 2006, the City Council held a public hearing regarding the establishment of uniform news rack locations along the following public right-of-way in the City: Crenshaw Boulevard; Prairie Avenue; Hawthorne Boulevard; Inglewood Avenue; Aviation Boulevard; Rosecrans Avenue; El Segundo Boulevard; 120th Street; and Imperial Highway; and

WHEREAS, on October 24, 2006, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 7068 establishing uniform newsracks along major traffic corridors of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend Resolution No. 7068 pertaining to the graphics and pedestal required for the uniform newsracks.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: In addition to the requirements for uniform newsracks specified in City Council Resolution No. 7068, the City will also require the following attribute specifications of uniform newsrack pedestals and the graphics of said newsracks. The pedestal required for all racks will conform to the specifications of the 10” x 10” small plate-style and will be the same color as the racks (RAL 6026). In addition, graphics of the uniform newsracks may be no larger than 4” in height, though they may extend the width of the uniform newsrack. .

SECTION 2. CEQA. This Resolution is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources Code Sections 21000, et seq., “CEQA”) and CEQA regulations (14 California Code of Regulations Sections 15000, et seq.) because, when implemented, it will cause a minor alteration to existing private facilities involving no

expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of this determination. This Resolution, therefore, is categorically exempt from further CEQA review under Cal. Code Regs. Title 14, Section 15301.

SECTION 3. CERTIFICATION/EFFECTIVE DATE. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution and thereafter the same shall be in full force and effect.
