Chairman Morton reported that the Foundation is still trying to finalize the money made from the golf tournament. There will be a golf tournament meeting August 6, 2008 to discuss where the next tournament will be held. Also the Foundation had a 20 X 24 plaque made with all of the sponsor's names on it. The plaque will be place at the Hawthorne Pool.

Assistant Directors Report:

- A. The pool renovation is still pending but we started lessons on July 12th. There are maybe 15 outstanding items left to do. There will be a grand opening on August 11th @ 12:00 pm. You are all invited.
- B. There was a 2.5% fee increase as of July 1, 2008.

- C. The 2008-09 Budget has not been passed.
- D. Still moving forward on the Teen Center.
- E. Summer Programs - The Park Program, Clinics and Summer Camp are going well. We are receiving a lot of participation.
- F. Senior Nutrition Program is allocated 75-80 meals per day. We are trying to increase that to 90 meals. We are also looking into having a meal on wheels program.

Commissioner Hughes apologized for not attending last meeting.

Commissioner Bowie invited everyone to the Holly Park Homeowners Association picnic August 16, 2008.
