**PROJECT 22 – NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION PROGRAM**

The amendment adds the new Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP), created by Federal legislation, the Housing and Economic Recovery Act (HERA) of 2008 on July 30, 2008.

Neighborhood Stabilization Program funds are proposed to be used for the acquisition, rehabilitation, and resale of foreclosed upon residential properties to low and moderate income eligible homebuyers. The City of Hawthorne was not eligible to receive direct funding from the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development as an entitlement community. The City of Hawthorne will submit a joint application with the City of Inglewood to the State Department of Housing and Community Development for funding from the Federal allocation to the State of California.

The project is an eligible activity as set forth in 24 CFR 5.110 AND 91.600.
