Assistant Director Hardison described the process for applying for upcoming available Proposition 84 Grant Funds and on meetings held with the Trust for Public Land in developing a new recreation project for the North end of the city and for the rehabilitation of Bicentennial Park

The City is considering a Solar Energy project. Doug Krauss is working on adding solar energy panels on the City buildings to save energy. The Memorial Center is a good candidate because the roof is flat.

Assistant Director Hardison outlined the Summer Programs scheduled, which include Swim Lessons, Sports Clinics, Park Programs, Classes and Day Camp. Swim lessons scholarships are available for low income families.
