Assistant Directors Report:

Alex Monteiro has resigned from the Parks & Recreation – Fine Arts Commission effective today.

- A. 09/10 Budget was approved by the City Council. Assistant Director Hardison gave the commission a copy of the departmental budget.
- B. Summer Recreation Programs are going well. Everyone is enjoying the wading pools and the park activities. The swimming lessons at the pool are continuing to sell out. The weekly sport clinics are also going well.
- C. Park Rangers – SBWIB received stimulus money and Code Enforcement and the Police Department decided to hire Park Rangers. Currently we have Rangers at Memorial Park and Eucalyptus Park & Skatepark.
- D. Banner Regulations are being brought back to the next council meeting.
- E. Fee Resolutions are adjusted annually. These are just fees that will be adjusted in the Recreation Department. (Kitchen fees, Commercial fees for movies and pool rental fees will increase.)
- F. There are a lot of new improvements at Holly Park. We are putting in a new irrigation system, painting the tennis courts, putting in new lights and new gates. The project should be completed by the end of October.
- G. Assistant Director Hardison announced that he would be on vacation during our next scheduled meeting. The commission agreed that Assistant Recreation Supervisor Kywana Bowie will feel in for the next meeting.
- H. Upcoming events are National Night out which is tonight August 4<sup>th</sup> at Ramona Park. Also there is a Farmers Market every Saturday at Dana School Field from 9-1pm.

Commissioners Comments:

Commissioner Jeppesen said the library has a new manager and she is doing wonderful things to enhance the library.

Commissioner Balboa said the Car Show was very nice and she also had lunch at the Farmers Market on Saturday. Commissioner Balboa will also be attending the National Night Out at Ramona Park this evening.

Commissioner Bowie asked when the renovation would be complete at Holly Park.
