- A. Winter-Spring 2010 classes have begun. We've combined the Winter-Spring session together in one brochure to save money. We are hoping this change will be well received by the community.
- B. Youth Basketball League – The Youth Basketball League will be starting February 12th. If you know any kids between the ages of 6-15 years old and would like to play basketball please send them to the Sports Center.

- C. State of the City Luncheon will be held on February 11, 2010.
- D. Electronic Round- Up will be held in the Sports Center Parking Lot on March 6, 2010.
- E. Bunny Breakfast - Our annual Bunny Breakfast will be held March 27, 2010.
- F. Prop. 84 – Concept A had the most votes by the community. There will be some minor changes to the drawing before the Grant is submitted in March.
- G. Memorial Center Solar Project – The City Council awarded the bid to a contractor. Once the job is complete there will be no Edison Bill for the Memorial, Senior or Sports Center.
