Unlicensed and Suspended Drivers License Checkpoint

On Wednesday, November 10, 2010, the Hawthorne Police Department will conduct a driver's license checkpoint. From 7:00 AM until 11:00 AM, the checkpoint will be on Marine Ave. at Gerkin Ave. From 12:30 PM until 4:00 PM, the checkpoint will be held at 116th St. and Prairie Ave.

These checkpoints are conducted in an ongoing effort to reduce the number of unlicensed drivers and traffic collisions within the city of Hawthorne. Driver's license checkpoints allow police to identify offenders and get them off the street, while providing an opportunity to educate the public on the dangers of unlicensed drivers. The checkpoints are a proven and effective method to achieve these goals.

By publicizing these enforcement and education efforts, the Hawthorne Police Department believes motorists can be deterred from driving without a license.
