Tonight is National Night Out and the participating parks are Holly Park Homeowners Association and Ramona Homeowners Association. There will be food, activities for kids and Adults. The event will last until 8:30 or 9:00 pm.

The 2010-11 Budget has not been adopted. The employee groups are currently in negotiations.

ClearWire wireless carrier is looking for a cell site at Eucalyptus Park. The City would have to lease additional ground space for the existing cell tower. The city has profit from leasing the space.

We are currently in week 6 of our summer park program. The wading pools are a huge success as usual. The parents and the kids are enjoying the program.

The sports clinics are doing well. Each week we get a least 25-28 kids. These are good activities at a low cost. There's 2 weeks left if you know anyone who is interested in basketball or soccer clinics.

Swimming lessons at the Hawthorne pool have sold out consecutive weeks. We are looking at adding additional lessons for fall 2010.
