

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE
CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE,
CALIFORNIA HELD OCTOBER 11, 2011.**

Mayor Guidi called the City Council, Community Redevelopment Agency, Parking Authority and Housing Authority meetings to order jointly and concurrently at 6:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers of City Hall, 4455 W. 126th Street, Hawthorne, California.

Deacon Tom Moske from St. Joseph's Church gave the evening's invocation. Long time resident Frances Stiglich led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chief Fager introduced K9 Handler Jason Moulton and Police Officer Sean Judd, October's Officers of the Month.

Marvin Jackmon, on behalf of the CEO and President of Southern California Edison, presented a Resolution of Appreciation to the City of Hawthorne for being a valued and significant part of Southern California Edison history.

Under oral communications, **Pat Donaldson**, President of the Hawthorne Chamber of Commerce, reminded everyone that the tribute/roast for Mayor Guidi will be held on October 14th at the old Northrop hangar at 6pm. ORDINANCE NO. 2009 (1st Reading)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE, CALIFORNIA ADDING SECTION 10.56.020 OF THE HAWTHORNE MUNICIPAL CODE PERMITTING THE OPERATION AND MOVING OF METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY'S ARTICULATED BUSES IN EXCESS OF THE MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT OF VEHICLE AND LOADS SPECIFIED IN CALIFORNIA VEHICLE CODE SECTION 35551.
