Following a major disaster, police, fire, and medical professionals may not be able to fully meet the demand. People will have to rely on each other to meet the immediate life saving and life sustaining needs, *especially* in that time when much needed assistance may be hours or days away from reaching your neighborhood.

Developed through FEMA, the **Community Emergency Response Training (CERT)** program provides basic training in safety and life saving skills for the public.

The course curriculum covers the following modules:

- ✓ *Emergency Medical Operations-Triage*
- ✓ *Light Search and Rescue Operations*
- ✓ *CERT Organization*

- ✓ *Terrorism*
- ✓ *Course Review*
- ✓ *Disaster Simulation Exercise*
